## GUEST CONVENIENCES

### HOUSEKEEPING

All guest rooms receive daily housekeeping services. If you do not wish your room serviced, please display the "Privacy Please" sign on your door when you leave for the day.

### ICE & VENDING

Beverage and Ice machines are available on the 4<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> guest room floors located at the end of the each hallway. Snack and Ice machines are available on the 5<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> guest room floors.

### INTERNET ACCESS

The Fluno Center provides complimentary wireless throughout the building and in guest rooms. No log-in required. The network name is Fluno. If you prefer to connect directly, an Ethernet cable is available in your guest room desk drawer.

### LAUNDRY/DRY CLEANING

Laundry and dry cleaning services are available twice a week (1) pick up on Monday and returned on Thursday or (2) pick up on Thursday and returned on Monday. Items must be turned in by 7:00 am at the Front Desk. Laundry tickets and reusable Green Garmento dry cleaning bags are available in your room. The dry cleaning bags are also available for purchase.

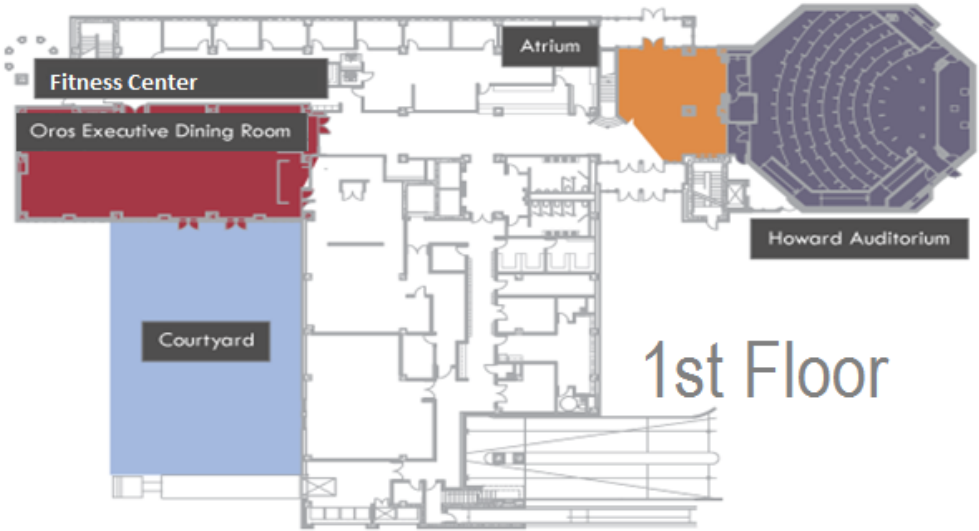

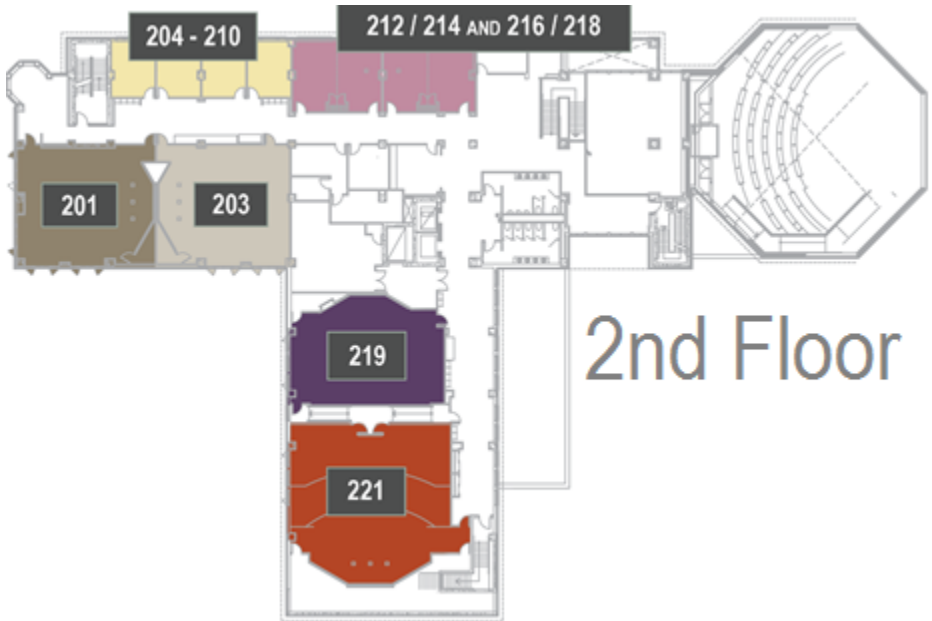

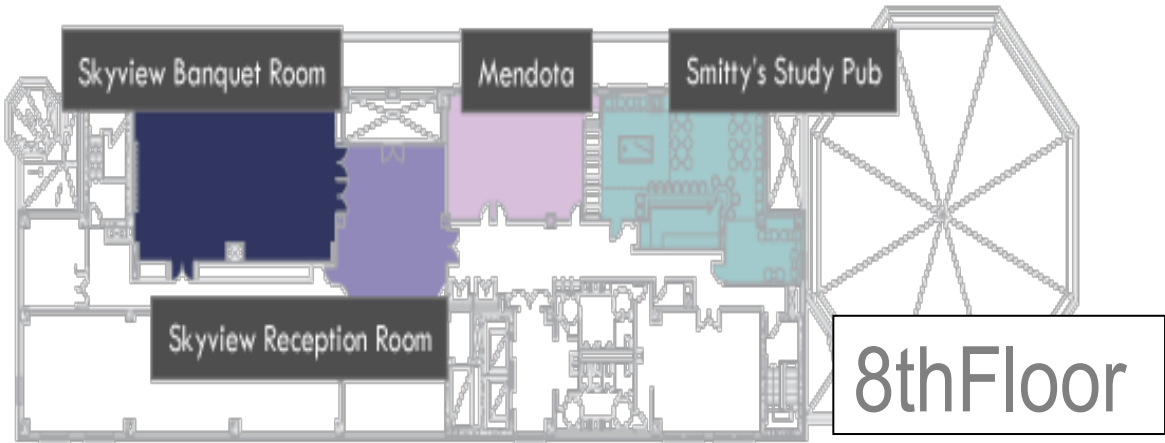

# EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

## EMERGENCY SIRENS AND LIGHTS

If the Fluno Center for Executive Education siren and lights are activated this means the fire alarm system has been initialized in the building. Everyone must leave the building immediately following evacuation signage on the back of the guest room door or in the meeting room.

## EXITS

The Center has stairwells on the East and West ends of the building that serve all eight floors. On the second floor there is an additional stairwell at the end of the South hallway, next to room 221, that leads out of the building.

## HOUSE PHONES

Throughout the Center there are black phones that may be used to call the Front Desk at any time of the day or night by pressing “0.”

## MEDICAL EMERGENCY

In the event of a medical emergency, please contact the Front Desk immediately by using a house phone and dialing “0.” If it is a very minor injury and only basic first aid is needed, you may call the Front Desk or stop at the Seminar Aide desk on the 2nd floor, or the Front Desk on the 1st floor, for assistance. To call the local fire or police department from any phone, dial “911.”

The Fluno Center for Executive Education has first aid kits and fire extinguishers located throughout the building. There is one Automated External Defibrillator (AED) located on the 1st floor next to the dining room. Fluno Center members are trained in First Aid, Adult CPR and in use of the AED. Upon notification of an emergency, our staff will take control of the situation by calling the Fire Department/EMTs or police as needed, bringing a first aid kit and AED to the injured person and providing basic care until professional help arrives.

## SEVERE WEATHER

The Fluno Center for Executive Education staff monitors the National Weather Service Emergency notification system at all times for weather-related watches and warnings. In the event of a weather related emergency that requires guests to move to a weather shelter, our staff will personally visit all meeting rooms and call all guest rooms to inform guests where to go for proper shelter. To monitor the weather forecast, tune the guest room television to Channel 65. To view local weather online, go to: [www.channel3000.com/weather](http://www.channel3000.com/weather).

## SAFETY TIPS

### *PREPARE*

Locate the fire exits, alarms, and extinguishers nearest your room and know how to turn off heating/air conditioning unit also, how to open and close windows. Know where your room key is at all times.

### *ACT*

If you are unsure whether or not there is a fire, notify the Front Desk. In case of a fire, touch your guest room door. If the door is hot, **DO NOT OPEN**. If you leave your room, take your room key and go to the nearest fire exit. Stay below any smoke that may be in the corridor. **DO NOT** use the elevators. All fire exit doors lead to stairwells. Enter the stairwell, close the door behind you and exit the building.

### *SURVIVE*

If you must return to or stay in your room, turn off the heating or air conditioning unit. Fill the bathtub completely with water. Wet sheets and stuff them completely around the door.

### *BLOCK VENTS EMITTING SMOKE*

Open windows only if you are sure fresh air is available and call the front desk by dialing 0 or use the direct dial button on your phone and give your room number or location. Keep a wet cloth over your nose and mouth. If the door and walls are hot, throw water on them with an ice bucket. Stay calm and do not panic.

### *IN OTHER CIRCUMSTANCES*

Whenever you are in a public area, observe the location of the fire exits. In case of fire or smoke, stay calm. Go to the nearest exit, stay beneath the level of smoke and exit the building.
